**A. General Information**

- Candidates can apply for registration for PG Admission counselling 2021 in “Online” mode only. Submission of Online Application Form may be done by accessing counselling board website [www.rajugpgayushcounselling.in](http://www.rajugpgayushcounselling.in) The Application Form other than online mode will not be accepted in any case. Only one application is to be submitted by single candidate.
- Candidates must follow the instructions strictly as given in the Information booklet on counselling board website. Candidates not complying with the instructions shall be summarily disqualified
- Candidates must ensure that e-mail address and Mobile Number provided in the Online Application Form are their own as all information/communication will be sent by counselling board through e-mail-on-e-mail address or SMS on given Mobile Number only

  - ❖ Download Information booklet and read these carefully to ensure your eligibility.
  - ❖ Follow the 4 steps given below to Apply Online:
 

**Step-1:** Fill in the Online Application Form and note down the system generated Application number.

**Step-2:** Upload scanned images of Candidate’s Photograph, Domicile Certificate, Caste Certificate (if applicable), Secondary Mark sheet, Senior Secondary Mark sheet, Mark sheets of B.A.M.S. (1<sup>st</sup> to Final), Internship certificate, Registration Certificate, AIAPGET-2021 Admit Card, AIAPGET-2021 Mark sheet in JPG/JPEG format.

**Step-3:** Make payment of fee using appropriate payment mode through appropriate payment gateway and keep proof of fee paid.

**Step-4:** Print at least two copies of Confirmation Page after successful remittance of fee.
  - ❖ **All the 4 Steps can be done together or at separate times.**

**Note: -**

- A.** The final submission of Online Application Form will remain incomplete if Step-2 and step-3 are not completed. Such forms will stand rejected and no correspondence on this account will be entertained.
- B.** No request for refund of fee once remitted by the candidate will be entertained by counselling board under any circumstances.
- C.** The entire application process of PG counselling is online, including uploading of scanned images, Payment of Fees, and Printing of Confirmation Page. Therefore, candidates are not required to send/submit any document(s) including Confirmation Page to Counselling Board through Post/ Fax/ By hand.
- D.** Candidates are advised to **keep visiting the Counselling Board website regularly** for latest updates.

## 2. Registration Fee

- A. All candidates are required to deposit registration fee of Rs. 2000/- (for General, EWS & OBC candidates) and Rs. 1500/- (for SC/ST candidate of Rajasthan state domicile) through Internet banking / Debit card / Credit card. The registration fee is neither refundable, nor transferable and nor adjustable for any future State PG admissions. Any plea in this matter shall not be entertained. Please keep the information submitted in application form confidential and do not share with anybody. If you don't register during registration period, you will not be allotted any seat. Please also note that registration will be available once only.
- B. AIAPGET-2021 qualified candidates may apply for counselling and admission to Ayurveda PG Institutions in Rajasthan, if eligible based on applicable rules, regulations, reservation policy and other criteria specified by Govt. of India/ Govt. of Rajasthan respectively.
- C. Counselling Board will propose its own merit list considering AIAPGET-2021 merit list and based on its applicable rules regulations, reservation policy and other criteria.
- D. Counselling will be conducted **online**. Merit list will be prepared on the basis registered eligible applicants as per rules. All admission will be made to the meritorious candidates as per rules of counselling

## 3. General Instructions, Terms and Conditions

- A. Applicants may note that appearance in PG Counselling 2021 does not confer any automatic rights to secure an AYUSH Post Graduate MD/MS. The selection and admission to Postgraduate seats in any AYUSH institution(s) recognized for running MD/MS courses as per the NCISM Act is subject to fulfilling the admission criteria, eligibility, medical fitness and other criteria as may be prescribed by the respective universities, AYUSH institutions, NCISM, State/Central Government
- B. Online Registration process will be conducted as per time schedule available at website.
- C. Applications of candidates producing false or fabricated information will not be considered and such candidates may be debarred from appearing in any future counselling conducted by counselling board.
- D. Before initiating registration process, candidates should go through the Information Booklet carefully for eligibility criteria, scheme and pattern of counselling etc. Any queries and other issues will only be entertained if the requested information is not given in the Information Booklet.
- E. Incomplete application, if not in accordance with instructions, will not be considered and is liable to be rejected. Applicant should carefully fill up all the fields during registration process. **Application cannot be modified/edited at any circumstances.**
- F. Instructions in the Information-Booklet are liable to change based on decisions taken by the Constitutional Authorities.
- G. Counselling Board reserves the right to withdraw permission, if any, granted inadvertently to any candidate who is not eligible to appear in PG Counselling even though Registration number has been issued or is displayed on website
- H. Counselling Board does not verify the information provided by the candidates during online registration and hence candidature will be purely provisional subject to the fulfillment of eligibility criteria as mentioned in the Information Booklet for PG Counselling & criteria of NCISM/ State/Universities/Institutions concerned.
- I. Candidates must verify from the respective state government/ Universities and Institutes if at all they will be considered for admission to All India Quota (in private college). State Quota Post Graduate seats based on applicable regulations and /or domicile criteria, State/Institute of Graduation, reservation policy fee structure etc. Merely appearing in AIAPGET 2021 does not make a candidate qualified and/or eligible for All India quota (in private seats)/State Quota seats for admission.

#### 4. COMMON FEATURES

##### A. Qualification for Admission:

Ayurvedacharya Degree (Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medicine and Surgery) of Universities of Rajasthan State or any equivalent Degree recognized by NCISM/CCIM.

(A) Candidates who have qualified in the AIPGET-2021 can participate in the counselling for admission in MD/MS(Ayurved) course for the academic year 2021-22.

(B) Minimum qualifying marks for AIPGET-2021 will be as specified in existing PG Regulation (ASU) as given below:

“The qualifying criteria for AYUSH MD/MS/ courses shall be as per NCISM and Ministry of AYUSH, Govt of India directions i.e., Indian Medicine Central council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Amendment Regulation 2018, In order to be eligible for admission to post-graduate courses for an academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum marks at 50<sup>th</sup> percentile in the AIAPGET 2021. Qualifying criteria for candidates belonging to scheduled castes, scheduled tribes and other backward classes, the minimum marks shall be at 40<sup>th</sup> percentile. Candidate with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities act, 2016 (49 of 2016) the minimum marks shall be at 45<sup>th</sup> percentile for General category and 40<sup>th</sup> percentile for scheduled caste, scheduled tribes and other backward classes.”

**B. Candidates:** Must have completed the six- or twelve-months rotating Internship/House Job, as the case may be, after passing the qualifying examination **by 31 December 2021 or as decided by The Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India.**

**C.** The online application form and time schedule are available on the Board website [www.rajuggayushcounselling.in](http://www.rajuggayushcounselling.in)

##### D. Counselling Procedure:

- i. Admission will be subject to the rules & regulation of the respective institutes.
- ii. Counselling Board reserves the right to correct any inadvertent error in any merit list and also in the prospectus.
- iii. The Counselling Board shall conduct counselling of the candidates and allot the institute/college and Subjects taking into an account the scheme of distribution of reserved seats, merit lists of respective categories, the order of the merit of AIAPGET 2021, preference and availability of seats.
- iv. The right of admission of any candidate who does not complete the prescribed internship by **31 December 2021 or as decided by the Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India** will automatically stand cancelled.
- v. Vacant seats arising due to any reason shall be filled by up-gradation on the basis of Reservations and Merit-cum-Preference List.
- vi. No TA/D.A. will be paid to the candidates for appearing in the Counselling.

##### E. Counselling, Merit List, Subject Preference and Allotment:

- i. The candidates will be allotted seats in institutions through online process on the basis of provisional merit list, Category, Subjects wise available seats and preference provided by the candidate in choice filling format.
- ii. For equal marks in AIAPGET-2021, the final merit will be decided at the time of counselling on the basis of BAMS Marks; therefore, candidate must fill-up his BAMS marks in application form. In case there is tie of the marks in AIAPGET-2021 merit list preference will be given to the candidate passing BAMS examination in first attempt in the higher percentage of the marks. If a tie still exists, the allotment shall be made giving preference to seniority in age.
- iii. candidate will have to deposit counselling fee Rs 30000/- (Rs Thirty Thousand only) through Net-banking/Credit Card/Debit Card by last date of choice filling till (As per Schedule available on website) and to submit choice filling performa failing which their admission shall cancelled and they will not eligible to participate in counselling process.
- iv. Once seats and college are allotted to the candidate in 1st round of counselling, the candidate will have to report in person at allotted reporting center and deposit prescribed remaining college annual fee only through Demand Draft payable to the allotted college during

- stipulated period of time. This candidate will also be eligible for 2nd round of counselling for upgradation. if he/she fills fresh choice filling form for 2nd round.
- v. If candidate doesn't report to the reporting center and doesn't deposit the prescribed remaining college annual fee with in stipulated period of time, his/her allotment will be cancelled and that seat will be treated as vacant seat. However, he/she may participate in 2nd round of counselling without forfeiting Counselling Fee as a last chance but he/she have to fill fresh choice filling form for 2nd round of counselling. For such candidates' seats will be allotted on availability of seats and on the basis of fresh merit list of round 2.
  - vi. A candidate allotted a seat in second round of counseling and does not report/ join the allotted seat, his/her counselling fee will be forfeited. Such candidate shall not be eligible to participate in subsequent round.
  - vii. If candidate after getting seat allotment in 1<sup>st</sup> round or 2<sup>nd</sup> round fails to report at reporting centers at the office of Counselling Board, Jodhpur on due date and time, his/her seat allotment will stand cancelled and counselling fee will be forfeited and will not be refunded in any circumstances. He/she may participate in next round of counselling in case of vacant position if any, only after fresh deposit of counselling fee Rs. 30000/- (Rs Thirty Thousand only).
  - viii. The counselling fee will be forfeited in case the candidate gives wrong information at the time of application on the basis of which a seat may be allotted and later cancelled by the Admission Authorities at the time of reporting.
  - ix. No candidate will be allowed to resign from the State Quota seats after allotment in 2<sup>nd</sup> round.
  - x. Those who applied but not allotted a seat in first round as well as second round will be considered for mop-up round of counselling (without fresh application form i.e., need not fill the application form again).
  - xi. A candidate without original certificates/documents shall not be allowed to take admission at the time of reporting at the office of Counselling Board, Jodhpur under any circumstances. A candidate who has already been admitted in PG course and has deposited his/her certificates in any college/institute/university and comes for counselling (allotment process) with a certificate stating that "his/her original certificates are deposited with the another reporting centers/college/institute/university, will also be allowed to take admission at the allotted college subject to production of ORIGINAL certificate issued by concerned Counselling Board/Head of the institution to this Counselling Board during his/her counselling, stating that the original documents of the candidate are deposited with them.
  - xii. The Counselling Board shall provide the list of provisionally allotted candidates to the concerned college.
  - xiii. Candidates are advised to visit Counselling Board Website and daily newspapers time to time for information of dates and other information's for participation in various rounds of counselling.
  - xiv. After mop-up round, once the AACCC AIAPGET-2021 merit list is exhausted and vacant seats thereof are transferred to Counselling Board Rajasthan, the admissions on residual vacant seats will be done on filling application form with UG/PG AYUSH Counselling Board Rajasthan in Stray Vacancy Round if needed.
  - xv. The Actual Admissions in a particular Institute will be subject to the rules and regulations of that Institute.
  - xvi. In-Service-Candidates are directed to upload NOC (No Objection Certificate) along with submission of choice filling proforma and counselling fees. NOC must be issued by competent authority of Ayurveda department of Govt. of Rajasthan on or before last date of online submission online Submission. After last date of online submission NOC will not be accepted/entertained.
  - xvii. Therefore, all in-service candidates must be very clear that they will get seat allocation only through online mode on their In-Service quota seats.
  - xviii. If the in-service seats remain vacant due to unavailability of in-service candidates, that vacant seat will be filled by the concern category of seats reserved for, from the non-Service candidate.

## **F. REPORTING TO COLLEGE AFTER COUNSELLING/JOINING TIME**



- i. Each candidate shall be given the time as mentioned in the allotment letter, issued on line, to join the allotted college and course. There is no provision of extension for joining date under any circumstances. The allotment made will be firm and final. Change of college/course from one place to another is not permitted. Therefore, request for the same would not be entertained by the Counselling Board after the allotment, except the candidate can opt for 2nd round of counselling for change of college as per allotment.
- ii. While reporting for admission, please carry all the relevant certificates/documents in original and also submit an undertaking (Proforma-1) on (Non-Judicial Stamp of Rs 50) that the submitted documents are in original.
- iii. The fact that a candidate has appeared for allotment shall not entitle him/her for allotment reallocation as the same will be subject to availability of seat and acceptance of the available seats at the rank of the candidate by him/her.
- iv. The selected candidates will be required to undergo medical examination at the allotted institution on the notified date(s).
- v. Provided that if any candidate is not able to report for Medical Examination at the Institution on the notified date on medical grounds or due to some other circumstances beyond his/her control and his/her parent/guardian comes in person on his/her behalf for verification of the original certificates to the college he/she will be considered for provisional admission. His / Her formal admission will be confirmed only when he/she is found medically fit and fulfills other requirements as per the dates notified.
- vi. Candidates who fail to attend medical examination on the notified date are liable to forfeit the claim for admission. Candidates who have been admitted must join their classes on the date to be notified.
- vii. The selection for this admission will be cancelled if the selected candidates do not report to the allotted college and deposit fees up to the stipulated date or whose particulars are not found correct or who are found medically unfit.
- viii. The selected candidates must also carry all requisite certificates and documents in original and also submit an undertaking that the submitted documents are in original along with 2 sets of printout of application form along with self-attested 2 sets of photocopies of the documents, at the time of reporting in Round 1, at the time of counseling of Round 2 and mop-up round and shall deposit the applicable fees of the allotted college and complete other formalities within stipulated time, failing which their admission shall stand cancelled.
- ix. The candidates must present the accepted resignation/relieving letter from the institution he/ she is pursuing studies at present, at the time of reporting. Failure to do so will result in disqualification for admission.
- x. The non-viewing of the websites about allotment information by the candidate shall not be accepted as a ground for non-reporting on the scheduled time and date. The candidate's allotment will stand automatically cancelled if he/she does not report IN PERSON at the office of Counselling Board, Jodhpur, as per the notified schedule.
- xi. A candidate shall have to deposit the full fee (Remaining) of the college for the session 2021-22, only through demand draft on reporting center at the office of Counselling Board within the notified time after the counselling.

#### **G. IMPORTANT**

- i. The candidates who do not join the allotted college will be treated as fresh candidate in the subsequent round of counselling.
- ii. Admission will be cancelled if the selected candidates do not report to the allotted college and Deposit fees with in stipulated period.

**Note: - No admission will be done by UG PG AYUSH Counselling Board, Rajasthan after cutoff date decided by Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India, New Delhi.**

#### **H. Reservations, Subjects and Admission Capacity:**

Subjects, Reservations & Admission Capacity are different in different Institutes.

- The distribution of seats in a particular institute will be as per the Rules & Regulations of the respective Institution and State Govt. of Rajasthan, Govt. of India and NCISM, New Delhi.
- Category wise reservation on AIQ seats will be given as per Hon'ble Supreme Court order dated 07.01.2022 on W.P. No. 961 of 2021
- Certain Seats are reserved for PH Candidates horizontally. These seats shall be filled from the Candidates belonging to the relevant PH Category on the basis of Merit.

**Note for Orthopaedic Physically Handicapped PH Seat as per Seat Matrix:**

- I. Candidate must possess a valid document certifying his/her physical disability conforming to judgments of Supreme Court of India i.e. with the approval of the Ministry of Health Family Welfare, Govt. of India vide letter no.18018/ 2/ 2009-ME (P-1) dated 17.02.2009 has been decided that while providing reservation in admission to medical course in the first instance candidates with disability of lower limbs between 50% to 70% shall be considered and in case candidates are not available of such candidates in that category then the candidates with disability of lower limbs between 40% to 50% will also be considered for admission subject to the outcome in the Writ Petition (Civil) 184/2005-Dr. Kumar Sourav Vs. UOI & others is pending in the Supreme Court of India.
- II. Disability certificate as per 21 Benchmark Disabilities given under RPWD Act 2016, from the designated disability Centers as per the list enclosed as ANNEXURE II. The certificate issued by any other hospital/board will not be accepted. Further, the format of 'Certificate of Disability' is attached in Annexure-I Seats

**5. Admission in the PG Courses of AYUSH Colleges in Rajasthan shall be available subject to approval by NCISM and Ministry of AYUSH Govt. of India, Govt. of Rajasthan and Affiliating University concerned.**

**6. Character/Conduct**

Candidates should bring the Character/Conduct Certificate in the prescribed form at the time of Counselling/interview. Admission of candidate whose character has not been found satisfactory during the degree course is liable to be rejected.

- **In-Service Candidates of State Government** who seek admission against the seats reserved for the said category must upload No Objection Certificate (NOC) issued by the Competent Authority while filling online application form on due time, failing which their application form will not be accepted by software.
- Candidates should clearly mention the Category (In-Service-General, In- Service-SC, In-Service-ST, In-Service-OBC General, SC, ST, OBC, PH) in the column Provided under which he/she seeks admission.
- In the absence of proof of belonging to SC, ST, OBC, PH, In-Service etc. such candidates will be treated as unreserved Category candidates.

**7. Miscellaneous:**

- i. The preference of subject and college given by the candidate at the time of choice filling will be final & no change will be allowed subsequently.
- ii. The Board reserves the right to accept or reject any Application Form or to amend any rule and regulation or cancel any admission without assigning any reason thereof.
